

Pledge To Turn Off Your Engine

The Flossmoor Community Relations Green Committee kicks off their first campaign, Idling Gets You Nowhere. The Committee asks all drivers to turn off their engines rather than let their engines idle. Idling seems harmless, but it isn't. According to the EPA, in urbanized areas cars are the single largest contributor to the ozone, which is harmful to our health.

Did you know that an idling vehicle emits 20 times more pollution than one traveling 32 miles per hour? Idling cars, particularly near schools and parks can also comprise the air our children breathe. Asthma is the third leading cause of hospitalization among children under the age of 15. For adults, breathing polluted air can trigger asthma, bronchitis, coughing, and chest pain. It increases susceptibility to respiratory infections and decreases lung function.

By making a conscious effort to reduce idling, we can reduce pollution by tens of thousands of pounds in our communities and protect our families from unhealthy air.

Now Do Your Share!

- Do not idle for more than 20 seconds.
- Park your car and go inside to order your food.
- Shorten the warm-up on chilly days. Warming up your car for a lengthy amount of time before driving is unnecessary.
- Choose your routes wisely. Avoid roads with high traffic volumes.
- Avoid using remote car starters. They encourage you to start your car before you are ready to drive.
- Spread the word to your family and friends. Tell them about the benefits of reduced idling.

Reporting a Power Outage

As part of ComEd's storm improvement plan, ComEd customers now have a variety of ways to inform the company about emergencies, outages, etc. ComEd's website at www.comed.com has all the tools you need to stay up to date on the latest notifications about your utility service.

With ComEd's Storm Center, you can get up to date information about outage restorations. Visit it on the web to report an outage and view the Outage Map. With the Outage Map, customers can view all the outages in the ComEd service area at once and get details on estimated restoration times and the status of crews working to resolve problems.

You can also text in a power outage or use the ComEd mobile app for iPhone and Android devices. Text the word OUT to 26633 and get updates until your power is restored, or download the free ComEd app available at www.comed.com.

If you have an electric emergency, call ComEd immediately at 1-800-334-7661. Never email your emergency request! If you need to report an emergency situation such as a fire, vehicle accident, electric contact/shock, or other potential danger, call 911 to notify local authorities.

Electric Aggregation Update

Flossmoor's electric aggregation program enrolled 3,190 customers with FirstEnergy Solutions, which will allow residential and small business customers to receive a fixed rate of 4.85cents/kWh for the next 24 months. Only 2 percent (roughly 80 account holders) opted out of the Village's program during the 21-day opt-out period.

Customers included in the program received confirmation letters from ComEd in July notifying them of the switch to FirstEnergy Solutions. Customers can cancel their switch to FirstEnergy Solutions beginning in August by calling FirstEnergy Solutions at 800.977.0500 or 866.636.3749, Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Also, any customer participating in the program can cancel their participation and go back to ComEd or another electrical supplier without penalty at any time during the duration of the 24-month contract.

If you did not receive a letter confirming your electricity supplier switch and would like to participate in the program, you must contact FirstEnergy Solutions to enroll.

ComEd will continue to deliver electric service to your home or business. Residents will continue to call ComEd in the event of a power outage, or if they have questions regarding billing.

What to Know, What to Do When It Comes to Flooding

This summer we experienced such a severe state-wide drought that flooding was far from most of our minds. However, flooding is the most frequent severe weather threat and the costliest natural disaster in the United States. Ninety percent of all natural disasters in the U.S. involve flooding. It is important to prepare now; it will save you later.

- Know safety tips and build an emergency supply kit. Include drinking water, a first-aid kit, canned food, a radio, flashlight, and blankets. Visit www.ready.gov for a disaster supply checklist or www.weather.gov/floodsafety for flood safety tips and information from the National Weather Service.

- Have a family emergency plan in place. Plan and practice flood evacuation routes from home, work and school that are on higher ground.

- Move important objects and papers to a safe place. Store your valuables where they won't get damaged.

- Protect your property. Consider a flood insurance policy. Most homeowners insurance does not cover flooding. If you have a flood insurance policy, make sure it is up to date.

AFTER A FLOOD

- Check for damage. Check for structural damage before re-entering your home. If you suspect damage to water, gas, electric or sewer lines, contact authorities.

FILE YOUR FLOOD INSURANCE CLAIM

- When filing your claim, be prepared with the name of your insurance company, your policy number and a telephone number or e-mail address where you can be reached.

- Take photos of any water in the house and damaged personal property. Adjusters need evidence of the damage and damaged items to prepare your repair estimate.

- Make a list of all damaged or lost items and include their age and value where possible.

Contact the Public Works Department at 708.957.4100 for guidance and information pertaining to flooding. In addition, they can answer your questions concerning the Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM).


