Heather Hill Elementary School Detention Basin Update — Aug. 14, 2024

Welcome back, students & families!

The Village of Flossmoor is committed to completing the construction project at Heather Hill Elementary School with as little interruption as possible to students & staff. Below are 5 important notes for you as the school year begins:

1. All work on the site will be paused for the first two days of school: Aug. 15 & 16. Work will resume Aug. 17 & 18. A project update will be provided by the Village the evening of Sunday, Aug. 18.
2. A crossing guard will be present as usual at the corner of Lawrence & Scott Crescent on all school days, and expect to see a police officer for extra traffic assistance the first few days of school.
3. Lawrence Crescent will be open for traffic. Please note that there may be intermittent lane closures during the next weeks due to paving and concrete work, but the flow of arrival and dismissal for students will not change.
4. No construction activity will be allowed on school days between the times of 8-9 a.m. and 3-3:45 p.m.
5. Until the permanent fence is installed, the Village will assist with recess supervision. The existing construction fencing will remain in place until all restoration work has been completed.
