

Heather Hill Elementary School Detention Basin Update — Aug. 18, 2024

Good evening, Heather Hill families:

Due to the intermittent and heavy rains on Friday night and Saturday, work at the detention basin site was unfortunately delayed this weekend. The crew has been focusing on pumping down the water in the basin so that the grading work and removal of excess topsoil can resume. Pumping will continue on Monday and no hauling will occur. The pavement and concrete work on Lawrence Crescent is expected to begin on Tuesday. Lawrence Crescent will remain open for traffic. Please note that there may be occasional lane closures; however, the flow of arrival and dismissal for students will not change. Also, no construction activity will be allowed on school days between 8-9 a.m. and 3-3:45 p.m. to make traffic flow as smoothly and safely as possible. The Village has also committed staff to assist the school during the recess period until the permanent fence is installed.
