The purpose of the Community Relations Commission is to support initiatives that foster inclusivity and unity through initiatives, events, and conversations. We want to create a space where all feel valued and respected regardless of differences.

The intent of the Community Relations Commission is to encourage and promote volunteerism and civic engagement that inspires residents to contribute their time and skills toward making a positive impact on the lives of others. We volunteer our time to foster a sense of belonging and collective responsibility. Our goal is to build a stronger, more cohesive community where everyone is represented and has equal opportunity to thrive.

The Role of a Community Relations Commissioner

- Advise the Mayor and Board of Trustees of ways in which the community can work together for the benefit of the entire Village.
- Study such matters that may be referred to the CRC by the Mayor and Board of Trustees and report and recommend on these matters.
- Represent the Village in regional activities when directed by the Mayor and Board of Trustees.
- Commit to volunteerism by collaborating on and actively participating in Village events.
- Encourage all residents to attend Village and other events that may strengthen a sense of community.
- Advise ways in which the Village can ensure inclusivity when planning community events and celebrations.
