

ORDINANCE NO. FMC-453

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 6, ARTICLE II
OF THE FLOSSMOR MUNICIPAL CODE

(2012 INTERNATIONAL FIRE CODE)

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Flossmoor, County of Cook, State of Illinois, that:

Section 1. Chapter 6, Article II is amended by deleting Section 6.201 in its entirety and the following new Section 6.201 is substituted therefore:

“6.201. Adoption of the 2012 Edition of the International Fire Code.

That a certain document, three copies of which are on file in the office of the Village Clerk of the Village of Flossmoor, County of Cook, State of Illinois, being marked and designated as “The International Fire Code 2012 Edition” as published by the International Code Council, be and is hereby adopted as the Fire Prevention Code of the Village of Flossmoor, County of Cook, State of Illinois; for the control of buildings, structures and premises as herein provided; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of said International Fire Code, are hereby referred to, adopted and made part hereof as if fully set out in this Ordinance, with the additions, insertions, deletions and changes, if any, as hereinafter prescribed, which may be referred to as the Fire Prevention Code.”

Section 2. Additions, deletions, insertions and changes to the Fire Prevention Code.

That the following sections are hereby revised as follows:

Section 101.1 Insert: Village of Flossmoor.

Sections 103.2, 103.3 and 105 are deleted.

Section 506.3 shall read as follows:

Fire Department Rapid Entry Systems.

A. All buildings regardless of use or occupancy, except residential buildings having less than four (4) dwelling units, which:

(1) Contain two (2) or more separate use and occupancy units;

- (2) which units do not have external access independent from the building's external access; or
- (3) all buildings which are protected by, or are required to be protected by an automatic suppression system

shall have installed an approved key box system.

Section 903.2 is revised to read as follows: Approved automatic sprinkler systems shall be provided in all new buildings and structures.

Section 907.2 is revised to read in the first paragraph as follows: An approved manual and automatic fire alarm system installed in accordance with the provisions of this code and NFPA72 shall be provided in all new buildings and structures.

Section 2301.1 Flammable and Combustible Liquid Motor Fuel-dispensing Facilities General is revised to read as follows: The storage of Flammable and Combustible liquids shall comply with state law requirements.

Section 3307 is revised to read as follows: The manufacture, use, handling and storage of explosive materials in any quantity shall be prohibited.

Section 5704.1 Flammable and Combustible Liquids Storage General is revised to read as follows: The storage of Flammable and Combustible liquids shall comply with state law requirements.

Section 6101 General is revised to read as follows: Storage, handling and transportation of liquefied petroleum gas (LP-gas) and the installation of LP-gas equipment pertinent to systems for such uses shall comply with this chapter and state law requirements.

Section 6101.2 is deleted

Section 6101.4 which shall read as follows, is added:

Liquefied Petroleum Gas Storage. The permanent bulk storage of Liquefied Petroleum Gas in quantities exceeding 500 gallons water storage capacity shall be prohibited.

This Ordinance shall be in effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.


